Washington Irving is the Celebrity Author for the ACLD Foundation's Eighth Annual Non-Event Gala



Since 2012, the Foundation has hosted an annual Non-Event Gala to raise funds for its work on behalf of the Alachua County Library District and its patrons. This year's Gala honors Washington Irving on the occasion of the 200th anniversary of the publication of *The Sketch Book of Geoffrey Crayon, Gent* (including his famed stories "The Legend of Sleepy Hollow" and "Rip Van Winkle").
