ACLD Foundation Hosts its Tenth Annual Non-Event Gala

Beginning in 2012, the Foundation has hosted an annual Non-Event Gala to raise funds for its work on behalf of the Alachua County Library District and its patrons. The first Gala

honored Charles Dickens on the occasion of the 200th anniversary of his birth. This year's Gala marks a 100th anniversary, that of the first stage production of R.U.R. (Rossum's Universal Robots) by Czech playwright Karel Čapek (in which the word "robot" was introduced to the world). The American première was in October, 1922, with 184 performances at New York's Garrick Theatre. Spencer Tracy and Pat O'Brien played robots in their Broadway debuts.

Our non-event Gala asks questions posed by R.U.R. in an age of artificial intelligence: "What does it mean to be human? How do we build a better society? Can I get a robot to scrub my toilet for me?" (Yes, RoombaTM, we're looking at you!)
